***Possible Components for Order of Service on August 10, 2025***

\* Pastor begins the service with the WHY of an emphasis on *Calling Out the Called*  
Matthew 9:37-38

\* Prayer for God's Spirit to move; for those whom He is calling to be sensitive and have ears to hear; to pray that those present will understand the role they have in *Calling Out the Called* in their church

\* Testimony of someone who was called out from your church (in person or via video)

\* Sermon (which may contain components of your own Call into Ministry), as you emphasize from Scripture that Almighty God still calls today,

\* Invitation (where an Invitation to salvation is always offered and on this day, attention is given and an Invitation is extended to those whom God may be calling; His call may be in a multiplicity of ways; only God calls, but you are there and your members are there to encourage and listen to those whom God is calling; His call may be very specific and the person will know exactly what God is asking; in other cases, God may use you and this church to help further define what God has planned; help the Congregation understand that all have the privilege of spurring on those whom God is calling.

Please let us know how God works in the service and in days to come, as we would love to rejoice with you as we all proclaim, *“To God be the glory!”*
